Home Energy Check-up

A Home Energy Check-up is a fast, easy way to increase the energy efficiency of your home and help you start saving immediately. When you schedule a Check-up, our energy efficiency professional will come to your home and check the condition of its insulation, heating and air cooling system, lighting, appliances, and more, to identify opportunities to help you save energy and money. If you let us install at least three energy-saving measures during the Check-up, **we will waive the \$40 Check-up fee and the cost of the energy-saving measures and their installation!**

How It Works

1. Walk-through. A Check-up professional will perform a one-hour walk-through of your home, to show you how you can reduce the amount of energy you use and save money. Your Check-up professional will assess the condition of the following items:

- Insulation levels
- Air leakage
- Heating and cooling systems
- Windows and doors
- Lighting and appliances
- Water heating equipment

2. Discussion of findings. After the Check-up, you will receive a report summarizing important findings, reduce your energy use and costs, while improving the comfort of your home.

3. Installation of energy-saving measures. The cost of the Check-up is a nominal fee of \$40. However, if you allow your Check-up professional to install at least three* of the following energy-saving measures, we will waive the Check-up fee and the cost of the energy-saving measures and their installation.

- Up to six compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs)
- Two faucet aerators
- Efficient-flow showerhead
- Water heater pipe insulation (installed on hot and cold pipes for six feet from water heater)
- Water heater tank wrap (electric water heaters only)

All CBPU residential electric customers are eligible to participate in the Home Energy Check-up.
