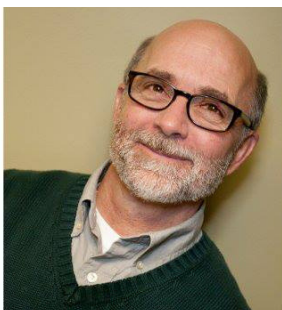
Content includes; key components of grant writing, choosing grant sources by focus area, logic model creation, and reporting/evaluation concepts.
