Description/ Qualifying Criteria: Scholarships awarded to graduating seniors from Barry, Branch, Calhoun and Eaton Counties who will be attending a trade school, community college and/or a four-year institution. Applicants must demonstrate financial need, leadership skills, involvement in the community and extracurricular activities. Preference may be given to applicants related to UAW members and/or retirees. Transcripts and scores are requested, but not necessarily a determining factor. Students who receive this scholarship may apply for further support in subsequent years.

Essay Question: Why have you chosen to go into your particular field of study? What goals and objectives have you set for yourself regarding college study and pursuit of a career? ***Please provide any relation(s) to UAW members or retirees.***

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a recent school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community, preferable an employer (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: ***Yes, complete the financial information portion of the online application and upload the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report.***
