

UAW Local 220 Scholarship

Description/ Qualifying Criteria: Scholarships awarded to graduating seniors from Barry, Branch, Calhoun and Eaton Counties who will be attending a trade school, community college and/or a four-year institution. Applicants must demonstrate financial need, leadership skills, involvement in the community and extracurricular activities. Preference may be given to applicants related to UAW members and/or retirees. Transcripts and scores are requested, but not necessarily a determining factor. Students who receive this scholarship may apply for further support in subsequent years.

Essay Question: Why have you chosen to go into your particular field of study? What goals and objectives have you set for yourself regarding college study and pursuit of a career? **Please provide any relation(s) to UAW members or retirees.**

Recommendation Letters: Two required- one from a recent school educator/administrator and one from an adult member of the community, preferable an employer (not a family member).

Financial Criteria: *Yes, complete the Marshall Community Foundation Financial Information form (available to download from the MCF website) and return, along with the first page only of your FAFSA Student Aid Report, with scholarship application.*

Application Process: Return the completed Marshall Community Foundation **4-page application** (available to download from the MCF website), including recommendation letter(s), essay question(s), transcripts and any other qualifying criteria to: Marshall Community Foundation, 614 Homer Road, Marshall, MI 49068.
